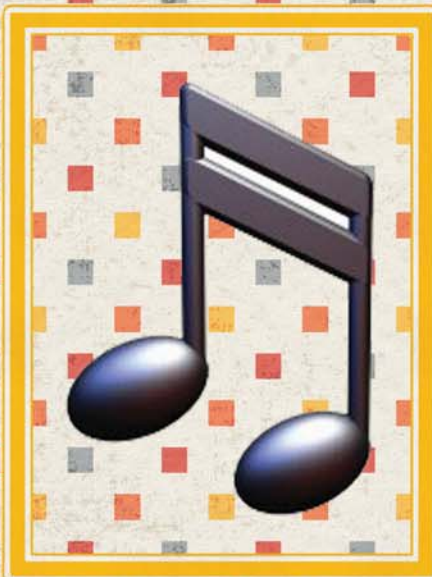


# Helicopters, Hooch, and Honkytonks



## Day One

Arrive in Clarksville and visit *Beachaven Winery*. The state's largest winery, known for producing award-winning wines and champagnes, Beachaven provides a glimpse into the centuries-old art of wine making. Beachaven is one of a handful of wineries that produce French Method Champagne. In addition to the tour and tasting, the group will enjoy "Wine for Dummies" – learning all you need to know about wine, from correct temperature and stemware, to how to use a corkscrew. Another special treat will be a "Cooking with Wine" demonstration. Each guest will leave with a souvenir. \$12.00

Our next stop is the beginning of *The Great Biscuit Bake Off*. We will return to the hotel for Biscuit Making 101. The group will divide into teams, each preparing a biscuit by a different method or recipe. The next morning we will have the biscuits baked and have a big country breakfast, choosing the winner of the Great Biscuit Bake Off.

(\$15.00 includes breakfast and an apron for each person).

After a brief rest at the hotel, your group will continue their patriotic day with an USO Dinner Show. After a delicious meal your group will be delighted by the sounds of the "Andrews Sisters" and the "Glenn Miller Orchestra." Of course, dancing and participation will be encouraged. \$35.00

## Day Two

Our Big Southern Country Breakfast, featuring the biscuits made the first day.

Tour Fort Campbell Military Base – home of the famed 101st Airborne Division's Screaming Eagles (Air Assault). Guests will tour the Don F. Pratt Memorial Museum, which traces the history of the Screaming Eagles from WWII engagements to Vietnam to Operation Desert Storm. View the various aircraft, military equipment and monuments on display. These massive machines are sure to capture the imagination of everyone as well as private memories. Also enjoy a guided tour of the post and special surprise demonstrations. (Lunch at Fort Campbell \$4.00 per person)

Depart for Nashville and check into downtown hotel.

Live music lives in Music City so spend the remainder of your evening soaking in the music scene in one of Nashville's many live music venues. The honky-tonks on lower Broadway offer an especially authentic glimpse into Music City!



## Day Three

Be a Star for a Day! The star treatment is what Nashville does best, and the *Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum* brings it all together in this very unique package offering. Your group begins with a personally guided tour of historic RCA Studio B, Home of 1,000 Hits, where music legends recorded timeless songs. They'll be inspired during their own recording session directed by a sound engineer right where Elvis himself stood to record over 200 songs. Then it's off to the Country Music Hall of Fame, where they can hear rare recordings of country's legendary performers, see behind-the-scenes films by today's stars, along with costumes, instruments and personal treasures from country music's past and present. After the excitement of touring and performing, your group will enjoy a home-style barbeque buffet and line-dancing lessons at the famous *Wildhorse Saloon*. We delight them one more time by playing their "latest hit" over the Wildhorse sound system.

After lunch, your group will head backstage at the "Mother Church of Country Music," the *Ryman Auditorium*!

Spend the remainder of the afternoon stepping back in time at *The Hermitage*, home of President Andrew Jackson. The Hermitage is the most authentic early presidential home in America, where you'll be an honored guest in the Jackson family mansion, the formal garden, slave quarters, and the original log cabin the Jacksons occupied in 1804.

Dinner at the Aquarium Restaurant or Rainforest Café in Opry Mills!

Experience the *Grand Ole Opry* – Nashville's must-see attraction and the world's longest running live radio show. As the home of country music, the Opry offers an incredible mix of talent to create an American experience like no other!



## Day Four

This morning you'll group will head to Lynchburg, TN, famous for the *Jack Daniel Distillery*! The Jack Daniel Distillery is the oldest registered distillery in the U.S., and where the magic of brewing this world-famous Tennessee Whiskey all happens. It's where Mr. Jack first crafted the recipe for Old No. 7. It's where the pure, iron-free cave spring water flows. And it's where every drop of Jack Daniel's Tennessee Sippin' Whiskey is still made today. Your group will dine in grand southern style at Miss Mary Bobo's before heading for home.
